

Counselor FAQs

What is the application process?

Students must submit an application as well as supplementary materials such as transcripts, two letters of recommendation, and an application fee. Standardized test scores are optional for Fall 2021 entrance. Interviews are recommended. Visit the application details page for the latest information and deadlines.

What do you look for in applicants?

Grove City College has always reviewed applicants holistically, considering academic abilities, extracurricular and leadership experiences, and Christian values and character.

How does Grove City College rank nationally?

Grove City has earned <u>numerous accolades</u> through the years. For instance, *US News and World Report* ranks Grove City College in the top tier of Best National Liberal Arts Colleges based on a number of factors, including graduation and retention rates, faculty quality, student selectivity, financial resources, assessments by other colleges and high school counselors, and alumni giving. *The Princeton Review* ranks Grove City College #8 in the list of Top 25 Best Schools for Internships, and PayScale ranks Grove City College in the top 12 percent of Best Value Colleges based on ROI (return on investment).

Which majors are offered?

Students can select from more than <u>60 major and 50 minors</u>, including Accounting, Business Analytics, Mechanical Engineering, and more.

What do students do for fun?

Students can select from more than <u>150 clubs</u>, including leadership, academic, professional, and service organizations, as well as Greek, sports, theater, and music organizations. The area boasts multiple parks for outdoor enthusiasts and for those interested in city attractions, Pittsburgh is approximately one hour south.

Can students earn Grove City College credits before matriculating?

High school students can earn Grove City College credits at a reduced rate by participating in the <u>Dual Enrollment</u> <u>program</u>. Grove City College offers many of the required general education courses online each term. In addition, Grove City College accepts <u>AP</u>, <u>IB</u>, and <u>CLEP scores</u> (select Advising Guides and then the respective exam).

Do you offer financial aid?

Grove City College offers a variety of <u>financial resources</u> for students. Students can be considered for need-based aid, merit scholarships, loans, and student employment. Grove City College does not accept any funds that derive in any part, directly or indirectly, from federal sources (including scholarship or loan funds). Students who receive any federal financial assistance are ineligible to receive credit from Grove City College.

Is Grove City accredited?

Grove City College is accredited by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education, an institutional accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation.
